
## Instructions for Removing the Water Flosser Water Tank:

- 1. Power Off the Device:
  - Ensure the water flosser is turned off.
- 2. Locate the Water Tank:
  - Find the water tank, typically located at the back or bottom of the water flosser unit. It's usually transparent and has a fill cap.



## 3. Release the Water Tank:

• Holding the unit with the front part facing away from person, pull the water tank downwards towards the front of the main unit.
